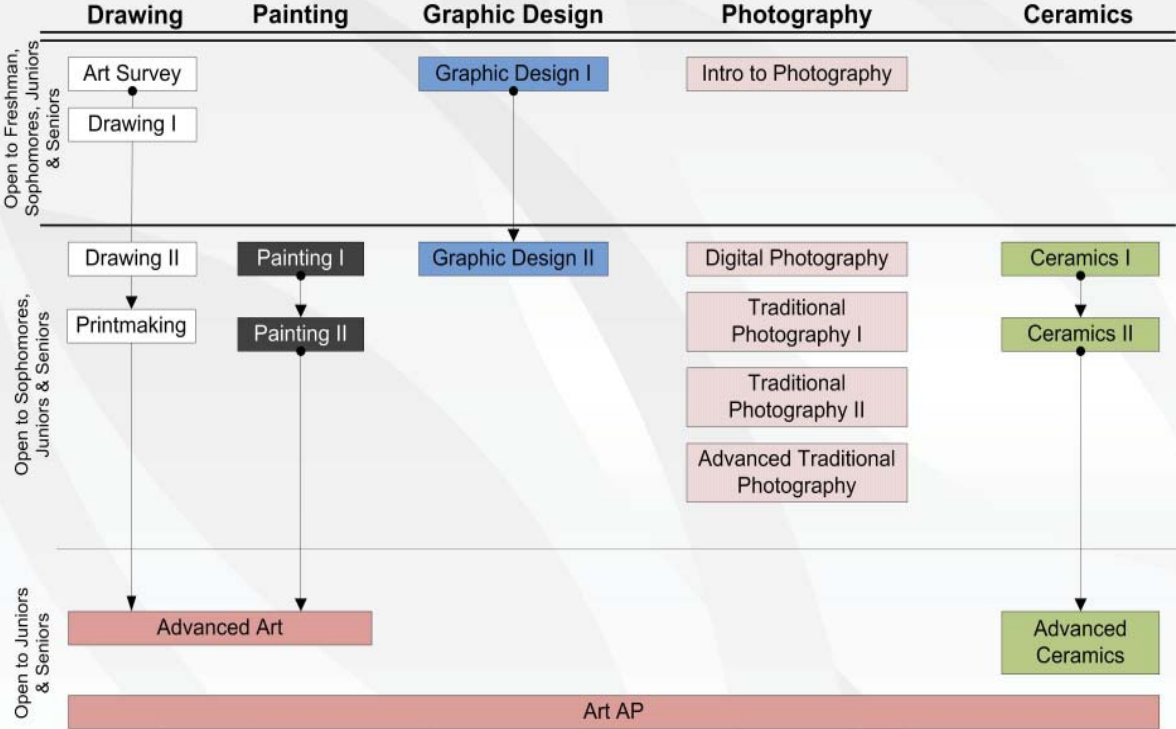

The Art Department has a comprehensive program that allows students to express themselves artistically in a variety of areas. One year of art meets the fine arts requirement toward high school graduation.

### ART SURVEY

ART100

ART SURVEY

**Elective:** Grades 9, 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** None

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

This introductory art course is designed for students interested in exploring the various forms of two-dimensional and three-dimensional art. Students get a taste of drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, ceramics and digital imaging.

### DRAWING I

ART110

DRAWING I

**Elective:** Grades 9, 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** None

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

This is an introductory drawing class where students learn fundamental drawing skills and techniques. Students create a variety of drawings using pencil, colored pencil, pen & ink, and pastel. This is a recommended starting point for all other art courses.

### DRAWING II

ART200

DRAWING II

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Drawing I or Art I

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students expand on the techniques learned previously and gain experience in new media such as charcoal, scratchboard, and mixed media. Students are encouraged to demonstrate individual expression through their work.

### PAINTING I

ART260

PAINTING I

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Drawing I or Art I

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students transfer their drawing skills to create form in paintings. Students experiment with tempera, watercolor, and acrylic paint. Composition and color theory are investigated to create realistic paintings.

### PAINTING II

ART270

PAINTING II

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Painting I or Art II

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

In this advanced study in painting, students focus on one type of paint in order to study that media in depth. Classic subjects will be investigated including still-life, landscape, and portraiture.

### PRINTMAKING

ART275

PRINTMAKING

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Art Survey or Drawing I or Art I

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students learn basic principles of printmaking by preparing and printing their images on several different surfaces. Students explore many types of print media including linoleum, plexiglas®, silkscreen, photo transfer, monotype, and sponge prints.

### ADVANCED ART

ADVANCED ART

**Elective:** Grades 11, 12. One unit

**Prerequisite:** A portfolio of 5 pieces of original artwork that demonstrate proficiency in the application of the elements and principles of art, and 4 semesters of 2D art classes

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

This year-long class will concentrate on portfolio development through the exploration of various media in the first semester and focusing on a media of the student's choice in the second semester.

### AP STUDIO ART

AP STUDIO ART

**Elective:** Grades 11, 12. One unit

**Prerequisite:** A portfolio of 5 pieces of original artwork that demonstrate proficiency in the application of the elements and principles of art and 4 semesters in the student's area of concentration

**Grade Weight:** Advanced Placement

This year-long class will concentrate on portfolio development through the exploration of various media in the first semester and focusing on a media of the student's choice in the second semester. Students have the option of concentrating in photography, 3D or 2D media.

### CERAMICS I

ART210

CERAMICS I

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** None

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students learn to express creative ideas in clay and gain a basic understanding of fundamental construction methods including coil, slab, sculpting, and glazing techniques.

## **CERAMICS II**

ART220

CERAMICS II

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Ceramics I

**Grade Weight:** Academic Core

Students are introduced to the potter's wheel and more advanced surface decoration techniques. The focus shifts to combining building techniques for a more creative result. Cohesive, well-built, and visually pleasing work is emphasized.

## **ADVANCED CERAMICS**

ART300

ADVANCED CERAMICS

**Elective:** Grades 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Ceramics II & successful completion of an independent project, indicated by a certificate of proficiency.

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students will need to obtain a certificate of proficiency to register for this class. Individual exploration is required. Students have the opportunity to develop their own style of work, through collaboration with the teacher.

## **INTRO TO PHOTOGRAPHY**

ART120

INTRO TO PHOTO

**Elective:** Grades 9, 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** None

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

In the photography portion of this course, students learn camera controls, compositional rules, and darkroom techniques. In the digital imaging portion, students use Photoshop to manipulate and correct the photographs taken during the first quarter of class.

## **TRADITIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY I**

ART280

TRAD PHOTO I

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Intro to Photography or Photo Technology I

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students gain an in-depth understanding of a manual SLR camera and continue to develop wet lab darkroom skills. Students experiment with traditional and non-traditional photographic processes. It is strongly recommended that students have a 35mm camera.

## **TRADITIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY II**

ART290

TRAD PHOTO II

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Traditional Photography I or Photo Technology II

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students engage in more advanced wet lab processes and explore new formats in film, paper, cameras, and enlargers. Students may also take field trips to explore photography in various lighting situations.

## **ADVANCED TRADITIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY**

ART285

ADV TRAD PHOTO

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Traditional Photography II or Photo Technology III and successful completion of an independent project, indicated by a certificate of proficiency.

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students need to obtain a certificate of proficiency to register for this class. Students utilize prior knowledge to create a self-directed portfolio for presentation to the class. Students research a master of photography and emulate his/her work.

## **DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY**

ART295

DIGITAL PHOTO

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Intro to Photography or Photo Technology I

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students build on knowledge gained in the Intro to Photography course. They explore personal interest in subject matter and shooting styles. Students will explore various digital computer programs.

## **GRAPHIC DESIGN I**

ART130

GRAPHIC DESIGN I

**Elective:** Grades 9, 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** None

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

Students use the basic tools learned in Digital Photography to further investigate Photoshop and begin to explore Illustrator, a very advanced graphic design program. Projects are designed to appeal to students' interests and utilize personal photographs.

## **GRAPHIC DESIGN II**

ART140

GRAPHIC DESIGN II

**Elective:** Grades 10, 11, 12. One half unit

**Prerequisite:** Graphic Design or Design for Print

**Grade Weight:** College Prep

In this advanced digital imaging course, students continue to experiment with Photoshop and Illustrator. By combining both programs, students create graphic projects modeled after common products used in the commercial design industry.
