Dear Parent/Guardian,

This is an exciting and busy time for your family as you prepare to send your student to high school in the fall. There are decisions to make, seemingly endless forms to complete, and deadlines to meet.

One of the most important deadlines is **July 30, 2021**, the date that your freshman's medical form is due in the Leyden High School Health Office. A freshman physical is required to be dated within one year of entering high school and also having all required immunizations. If the State of Illinois Certificate of Child's Health Examination form is not received by October 15th, 2021, your child may be excluded from school on October 15, 2021 until the forms have been completed and turned in.

IMPORTANT: Please be sure that all required components of the form are completed. This includes dates of all immunizations (these can be obtained from your physician or from your child's middle school) and the health history portion (located on back of form) completed and signed by you. The physical examination form must have all the requirements completed, signed and dated by the physician with his/her name and address. This will avoid us having to return the form to you for completion.

In an effort to emphasize the importance of meeting the July 30th deadline, the Leyden Board of Education has approved the following guidelines:

**All freshman medical forms are due in the Health Office no later than Friday, July 30, 2021. After the July 30th deadline, a late fee will be applied for freshman medical forms received after the due date:
Beginning July 31st a \$50.00 late fee
All late fees will be due no later than Friday, August 6, 2021.**

****NEW CHILD DENTAL EXAM REQUIREMENT****

Illinois school code now requires **students entering ninth grade** to have a dental examination before May 15th of the freshman school year. Freshman students need to submit proof of a dental exam or waiver by May 15, 2022. School dental examinations must have been completed within 18 months prior to the May 15, 2022 deadline. If a student fails to provide proof by May 15, 2022, the student's report card may be held.
