Requirements:

- 17 years old to apply
- Original Social Security card,
- High School Diploma, GED or transcripts showing completion of two years (eight credits) of high school
- Recommendation letter from local union OR letter of intent to hire from a contractor
- Physically fit to work as a carpenter

Entry Process: Through contractor sponsorship and apply in-person at Carpenters Training Center in Elk Grove Village; or contact local union for recommendation letter, then apply at Carpenters Training Center. Candidates must pass an aptitude test measuring vocabulary, arithmetic, and reasoning.

Openings: Not open at this time.

Applicants must be able to perform the essential functions of the apprenticeship program. A drug test is required as a condition of employment. Marijuana is included in the list of prohibited substances.
