Leyden High School Scholarships

A brief description of each scholarship is listed below. *Please note that scholarships offered, the number of scholarships awarded, and monetary amounts are subject to change.*

Chamber by O'Hare (Franklin Park/Schiller Park/River Grove Chamber of Commerce) Manufacturing Technologies Scholarship (East Only)

One \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a student in the Franklin Park/Schiller Park/River Grove area who plans to pursue a degree in an engineering technology/manufacturing related academic area at Triton College.

Chamber by O'Hare (Franklin Park/Schiller Park/River Grove Chamber of Commerce) Scholarship (East Only)

Two \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to two students in the Franklin Park/Schiller Park/River Grove area who demonstrate leadership in school, extracurricular activities, employment and/or extraordinary personal situations. The students must be enrolled full time, and admitted to a college/university (2 or 4 year) to receive the award.

Donald E. Stephens Scholarship

Three monetary awards of \$5,000 each will be given to qualifying students who will attend an accredited college or university in the fall of the year of graduation. Two awards are for academics and one award is for varsity athletics. Criteria for selection will be: rank in the top 25% of the graduating class, based on 7th semester weighted rank; extracurricular involvement; and community service.

East Leyden Parents' Club Scholarship (East Only)

Several scholarships up to \$500 will be awarded to East Leyden students whose parent(s)/guardian(s) are members of East Leyden's Parents' Club. Criteria for selection will be: "C" or better GPA and plans to continue formal education at the junior college, college, technical, or trade school level.

Franklin Park PTA/Hester Junior High Scholarship

Several \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduates of Franklin Park District 84 School-Hester Junior High School. Criteria for selection will be: a minimum 2.5 unweighted GPA and plans for enrollment at an accredited college or university.

Gene Haas Scholarship

Six \$4,166 scholarships (3 East & 3 West) will be awarded to students who intend to enroll in a college level machinist-based training or engineering program. Criteria for selection will be: Minimum GPA of a 2.5, taken Metals I or currently enrolled in the class, financial need.

(GFWC) Franklin Park Woman's Club Scholarship (West Only-2017)

One \$500 scholarship will be offered to an East or West student. (The scholarship will rotate between East Leyden in odd years and West Leyden in even years.) The scholarship is intended to award a male or female student who has average grades, many of whom are worthy of a scholarship but do not meet the strict GPA or test score requirements of other scholarships. Criteria for selection will be: plan to attend a two-year community college or a vocational/technical institution after graduation and significant community service involvement. Student must attend club's annual meeting in April as part of the requirements to receive the scholarship.

Gottlieb Memorial Hospital Scholarships

Two different types of scholarships are available: 1) Two \$1,000 Gottlieb Memorial Hospital: Auxiliary/Medical Staff Scholarships will be awarded to one East Leyden and one West Leyden student; 2) One \$1,000 Dr. Dilip and Dr. Krishna Patel Scholarship will be awarded to a student from an area high school. By completing the Gottlieb appendix of the application, you will be considered for BOTH types of scholarships. Criteria for selection will be: plan to attend college, intend to pursue a medical health-related career, and academic achievement.

Hameeda Khan STEM Scholarship (West Only)

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to West Leyden students planning to enroll in a STEM program at an accredited college or university. Criteria for selection will be: a minimum 3.0 weighted GPA, based on 7th semester grades, financial need.

Illinois Federation of Teachers, Local 571: Leyden Council Scholarship for Future Educators

Two \$250 AFT scholarships will be awarded to one East and one West student who intend to pursue a career in education. Criteria for selection will be: a minimum 3.0 GPA, extracurricular involvement, and proof of acceptance to an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

Kevin “Big Kat” Kriston Foundation Scholarship (East Only)

Three \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded to East Leyden graduating seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Students need to plan to continue their education by attending an accredited college (2 or 4 year) or trade school.

#leydenpride Scholarship (East Only)

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to an East Leyden graduating senior who has demonstrated a commitment to #leydenpride throughout his/her high school career. Specifically, the student will have demonstrated the vision of East Leyden High School: exhibiting kindness, finding his/her passion, and committing to excellence.

Leyden High School District 212 Foundation Scholarship

Four \$2,000 awards will be awarded to two East and two West students. Criteria for selection will be: intend to further education in the fall of the year of graduation by attending an accredited college or trade school, weighted rank in top 50% after 7th semester, extracurricular and out of school activities, and community service.

Leyden Township/Carl Fiorito Scholarship Fund

Two \$1,500 scholarships will be given to one East and one West student. Criteria for selection will be: plan to attend a two- or four-year college or university, community service involvement, overcome difficult circumstances or hardships in pursuit of education, and demonstrate financial need. Scholarship finalists must participate in an interview.

Lucia Ramirez Community Involvement Scholarship

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to one East Leyden and one West Leyden student. Applicants must demonstrate a strong record of school and community involvement.

Norm Goodman Memorial Scholarship (East Only)

One \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to an East Leyden graduating senior. Criteria for selection will be: male or female varsity athlete who demonstrates teamwork, leadership, and sportsmanship; plans to attend accredited two-or four-year college or university.

Northlake Chamber of Commerce Scholarship (West Only)

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who are residents of Northlake. Criteria for selection will be: plan to attend an accredited two- or four-year college or university in the fall after graduation, with the intent to eventually earn a four-year (bachelor's) degree.

Peer Leader Scholarship *(East Only)*

One scholarship for \$1,500 may be awarded to a graduating East Leyden senior, who participated in the East Leyden Peer Leader Program. Criteria for selection will be: participation in Peer Leading, demonstrated leadership at ELHS and/or the community, post-secondary plan of attending an accredited 2 year (with intention of transferring to a 4 year) or direct admission to a 4 year institution, 2.5 GPA and an ACT score of 21 or higher, and participation in a possible finalist interview.

Rhodes School PTA Scholarship

Two \$300 scholarships, along with the available college textbooks for one year of college, will be awarded to students who have graduated from Rhodes School District 84.5. Criteria for selection will be: plan to enroll and attend an accredited two- or four-year college or university full-time (minimum 12 credit hours per semester), academic performance, and extracurricular involvement.

Robert Radak Memorial Scholarship

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to an East or West Leyden senior who intends to pursue a career in law enforcement or criminal justice. Criteria for selection will be: plan to enroll in police science or criminal justice courses at an accredited two- or four-year college or university in the fall of the year of graduation.

Rotary Club of Chicago-O'Hare Scholarship

Five \$3,500 scholarships will be awarded to qualifying students. Criteria for selection will be: must live or work in the service area of the Rotary Club of Chicago-O'Hare OR have a parent or guardian who works full-time in the Club's service area (service area is O'Hare Airport, Franklin Park, Schiller Park, Rosemont, and a portion of Northwest Chicago); must enter an accredited four-year college or university, community college, or trade school no later than the fall after graduation; demonstrate financial need; and display traits that reflect the ideals of Rotary. Scholarship finalists must participate in an interview.

Rotary Club of Chicago-O'Hare—Northern Illinois University Scholarship

One \$3,500 scholarship will be awarded to a Leyden student who is planning to attend Northern Illinois University (NIU). This scholarship is sponsored by a Rotary member and an anonymous NIU Administrator who wishes to make college education more affordable to young adults from the Club's service area.

Roy Achievement Scholarship

One \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a former student at Roy School for a minimum of three years. The student must carry a minimum of a "C" average, cumulative throughout high school, with no failing grades during Junior and Senior years. Students applying must have made some contributions or volunteered in the community (outside of school). The student should plan to enroll in a college, university or a trade school and seek a degree or diploma.

Roy Education Scholarship

One \$300 scholarship will be awarded to a former student at Roy School who maintains a "B" cumulative GPA throughout high school with no failing grades during junior and senior years. The student should be applying or already enrolled in a college or university, seeking a degree or diploma in education. Students applying should also have made some contributions or volunteered in the community.

Rundquist Opportunity Scholarship *(East Only)*

One \$4,000 scholarship (\$2,000 freshman year and \$2,000 sophomore year) will be awarded to an East student who has overcome challenges in pursuit of education. Criteria for selection will be: minimum weighted GPA of 3.0, demonstration of financial need, and strong motivation to continue education on a full-time basis after high school.

Smerz-Horvath Athletic Scholarship

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to one East Leyden and one West Leyden senior. Criteria for selection will be: athletic involvement in some context during high school. The scholarship is not just for the athlete, but for any student that has been involved with any aspect of Leyden athletics (scorekeeper, team manager, concession stand helper, etc.).

West Leyden Parents' Club Scholarship *(West Only)*

Several scholarships in the amount of \$250 will be awarded to qualifying West Leyden students who continue their education beyond high school. The student must plan to attend an accredited college or trade school after the year of graduation.

Woman's Auxiliary of Leyden Republican Woman Organization Scholarship

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to one East and one West student. Criteria for selection will be: community involvement, financial need.
